

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION.

COUNTY OF NEW YORK: SS:

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the membership Corporation Law, all being of full age, at least two-thirds being citizens of the United States and one of us a resident of the State of New York, do hereby certify and state:

FIRST: The particular objects for which the corporation is to be formed are

To encourage the propagation of thoroughbred Bulldogs, especially in the United States of America.

To promulgate a "Standard", to secure uniformity of type for excellence in the breed, and for the guidance of breeders and bench-show Judges.

To stimulate interest in public exhibitions and to safeguard the interests of breeders and exhibitors of bulldogs.

To further the interests of the breed by fostering the just claims of the bulldog to greater public favor.

SECOND: The name of the proposed corporation is THE BULLDOG CLUB OF AMERICA.

THIRD: The territory in which its operations are to be principally conducted is The United States of America.

FOURTH: The town, village or city in which its principal office is to be located is the City of New York, in the County of New York and State of New York.

FIFTH: The number of its directors is nine.
