Extracts From CHAPTER 19, SECTION 1, of the Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows

"At a show where there is benching, and to which an admission fee is charged, dogs (except *puppies) which are PRESENT must be on their benches, being prepared for showing at their boxes, in their show rings or exercising rings, or en route thereto or therefrom, during the advertised hours of the show's duration.

"A dog shall be in its box only before and after the advertised hours of the show's duration, except for a period of one hour before the advertised time of judging of its class, or by written permission of the show superintendent. (At an outdoor show, motor vehicles shall be classified the same as boxes.)

"*Puppies, irrespective of the classes in which they are entered, need not be brought to a show until the opening of the show on the day on which they are to be judged. They may be permanently removed from a show after the closing hour on the day their classes have been judged. Puppies need not be benched until after their classes have been judged."

BULLDOG CLUB OF AMERICA

— Futurity Rules —

1947-1948

Bertha B. Quintana, Futurity Chairman, offers four Sterling Silver Medals to be awarded to the **Breeders** of the Puppies placing First, Second, Third and Fourth, in the 1948 class of the Bulldog Club of America Futurity Stakes to be judged at White Plains on December 5, 1948. (One medal is offered for each placing **only**.)

1. This Futurity is open to all owners of registered Bulldog bitches in America, whether members of the Bulldog Club of America or not.
2. Bitches must be nominated before whelping. Nomination fee of \$2 must accompany nomination.
3. Puppies to be kept eligible must be entered within 50 days from date of birth. Fee one dollar (\$1), with identification, sex, color, markings, for each puppy entered.
4. Puppies from eligible bitches must be whelped at least 6 months prior to date of Futurity. (Prior to June 5, 1948.)
5. Final entry fee of three dollars (\$3) for each puppy kept eligible must be paid thirty days prior to the date of the Futurity. Proper identification, parentage, name, sex, color, to accompany payment.
6. All payments to be made strictly per above rules, and paid to Chairman of Futurity at address given below.
7. Eligible puppies sold may compete in Futurity provided all requirements in eligibility are fulfilled by new owners or taken care of by breeder with new owner's consent.
8. All eligible puppies to be shown must be entered in a regular class at the show.
9. Any permanent club trophy award will be made to the club member owning or breeding the best puppy placed fourth or better.
10. Owners of winning pups, but not members of the Bulldog Club of America, will receive a medal in lieu of any permanent club trophy.
11. Fees paid will not be refunded.
12. The total monies will be divided as follows: First, 40 percent; Second, 30 percent; Third, 20 percent; Fourth, 10 percent.
13. If less than four dogs compete, the division of stakes as outlined above shall apply and all monies left over shall be applied to the Futurity of the following year.

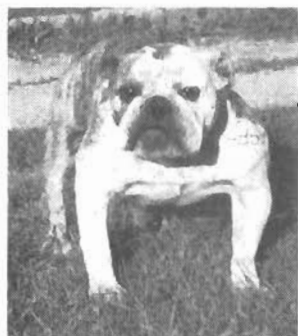

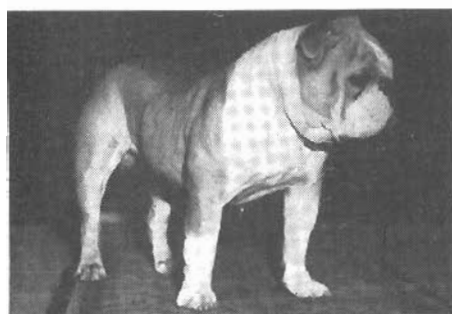

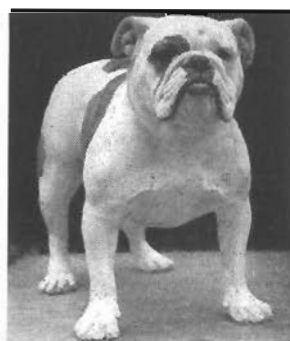
