THERE were 19 Bulldogs entered which I consider a very nice entry of Sourmugs for the Cincinnati show, thanks to our local Bulldog hustlers. The *Winners Dog*, *Best of Winners* and *Best of Breed* was Vardona Lord George, an outstanding dog, full of class and true to type. He was well handled by Jimmie Sullivan. Dr. Vardon is to be congratulated on owning such a fine specimen. The three points which Lord George received must about complete his championship as he had previously acquired points at the Chicago Specialty, Toledo and Columbus.

Reserve Winners Dog went to Thunderation owned by Mrs. Bertha Diehm of Cincinnati and handled by his former owner, W. H. Orton, Gahanna, Ohio. Thunderation showed as if he understood what it was all about. It is just too bad that Thunderation, a *good little dog* (under 45 pound) had to compete against a *good big dog* like Lord George. Notwithstanding, Thunderation has about 11 points towards his title.

Winners Bitch: This honor went to Madame Rackette Here, owned by Mrs. John C. Ferris, Camden, Ohio. She is a beautiful bitch and has already 11 points. She was sired by Morovian Midshipman and her dam was Irish Molly Oh.

He has been shown twice so far this spring, winning two firsts at Cleveland and Best of Breed, second non-sporting at Dayton. He will be shown again later this spring.

The rest of the dogs have done fairly well. Milady O'The Snows was Best of Breed and best non-sporting at Canton, where we only showed one dog. She was also Winners Bitches at Cleveland. Lord George was Winners at Toledo, Best of Breed and Best Non-Sporting at Columbus and Best of Breed at Cincinnati.

Mr. Morehouse of Farmington reports three females in whelp to Lord George. Mr. and Mrs. Ferman of Detroit are also expecting great things when this female whelps to Lord George. Sonny Boy has been bred to two females since his arrival. One owned by Mr. Morehouse of Farmington and the other, Blue Duchess, belonging to Mr. Irving Windt of Detroit. We have also bred one of our own females to Sonny Boy. We have also had three breedings recently to Vardona Watchman, a home bred son of Parkholme Watchman, including one owned by Mr. Grant of Toledo and Monmer Gypsy owned by Walter Schmidt of Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan.

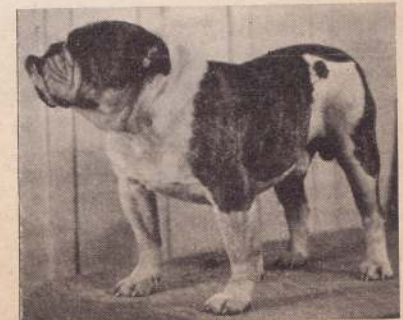
