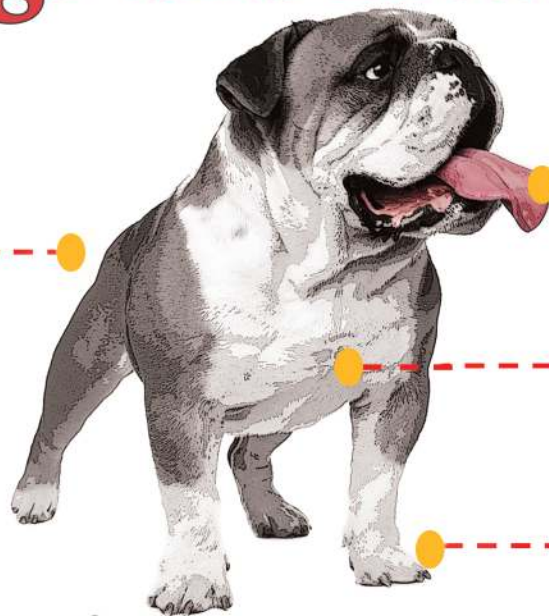


# Bulldogs and Heat Stroke



- ✓ Body Temp (rectal) is above 103° to 110 °
- ✓ Sudden diarrhea or vomiting

- ✓ Excessive panting
- ✓ Tongue/gums bright red
- ✓ Dry or sticky tongue

- ✓ Rapid heartbeat and breathing

- ✓ Disoriented/seizures
- ✓ Stumbling

## What to Do:



- ✓ Offer small amounts of room temp water. Do not force dog to drink if vomiting.



- ✓ Get dog indoors and if possible, with a fan blowing on dog.



- ✓ Call or take dog to Vet immediately.



- ✓ Use cool and wet hand towel at neck and/or belly, rinsing often with cool water. If possible, fill ziplock bag with ice, and place at neck.



- ✓ Spray rubbing alcohol on bottom of foot pads/feet and belly.  
*\* Only use rubbing alcohol if dog is overheated and temp is above 103°*
